NEWTON ABBOT. Writing of Thomas Marshall of Teyngrace, Co. Devon, Gent, reciting that Hugh Fortescue of Wayer, Co. Devon, Esq, now deceased (at the earnest entreaty of John Drew of Ford, Gent, and of Susanna his wife, and with the agreement of Robert Dyllon late of Chymwell, Esq, by deed dated 28 Sept. 41 Eliz.
